1. Version 3.3 of this product supports RX02 flexible diskette drives in addition to the RX01 drive. RX02 drives strapped to RX01 mode are also supported. All drives on a system must be of the same type.

This support is completely automatic and transparent to the user.

The RX02 drive is only used by WPS in single density mode. No additional storage capacity is available. No support of double density mode is planned.

2. Changes have been made to the printer menu to support future DEC printer products. Documentation of the new features will be made available when those products are available.

Printer destination devices SQ1 and SQ2 are reserved for future use.

SE options FRONT, REAR, and ALT are reserved for future use.
